Administrative Organization and Roles

Central Office Administration (Associate/Assistant Superintendents)

Under the supervision of the Superintendent of Schools the Central Office Administrators (Associate and Assistant Superintendents) serves as the District leaders of their assigned area of responsibilities. In that capacity, the associate and assistant superintendents are responsible for the implementation of Board policies and regulations. Each associate and assistant superintendent will annually e evaluated on the leadership they provide.

The associate and assistant superintendents may be employed by the Board for a term of for one (1) to two (2) years. The terms of the associate and assistant superintendents employment will be contained in a written contract signed by the associate and assistant superintendent, the Board President and the Board Secretary.
